



What is Tasmanian HealthPathways?

Tasmanian HealthPathways is an **online portal** designed to be used by health professionals at the point of care. HealthPathways aims to guide best-practice assessment and management of common medical conditions, including how to refer patients to local specialists and services in the most timely and efficient way. It is based on the HealthPathways approach developed by the Canterbury District Health Board of New Zealand, New Zealand and Australia. Primary Health Tasmania, in collaboration with Tasmanian health professionals (GP's, hospital specialists, nurses and allied health professionals) are developing the pathways that sit on the portal, ensuring they suit the local setting and meet local needs. The pathways cover a variety of clinical areas including cardiology, diabetes, respiratory, neurodegenerative conditions, palliative care, orthopedics, allergy, ENT, gastroenterology, child health, immunisation, mental health, wound care, refugee and migrant health, haematology, oral health and dermatology. The Tasmanian HealthPathways website is accessible to GPs and other Tasmanian health care providers, including nurses and allied health professionals.

How will HealthPathways benefit Tasmanians?

Tasmanian HealthPathways will result in a smoother, more connected care journey for Tasmanians. It is designed to ensure more people get the right treatment or specialist care in the right place at the right time, with less waiting time.

HealthPathways enables GPs and other health professionals to better help patients by outlining:

- ✔ the best available management and treatment options for common medical conditions
- ✔ information on how to refer to the most appropriate local services and specialists
- ✔ educational resources and information for clinicians and patients.
