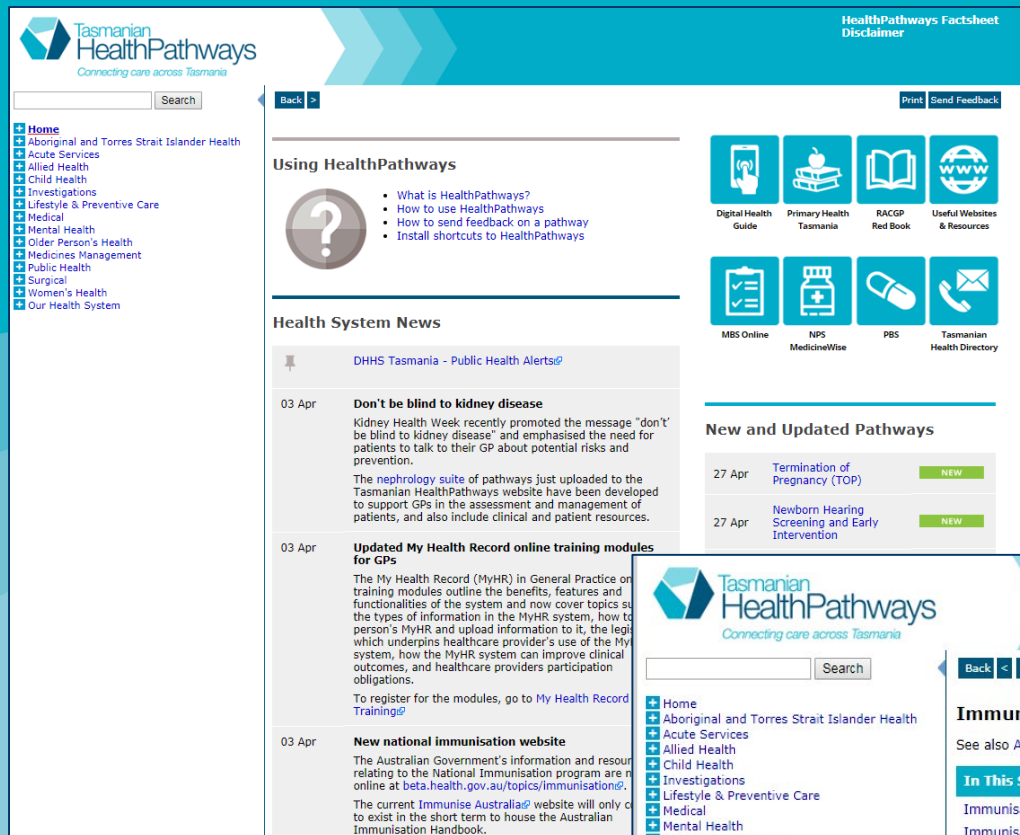

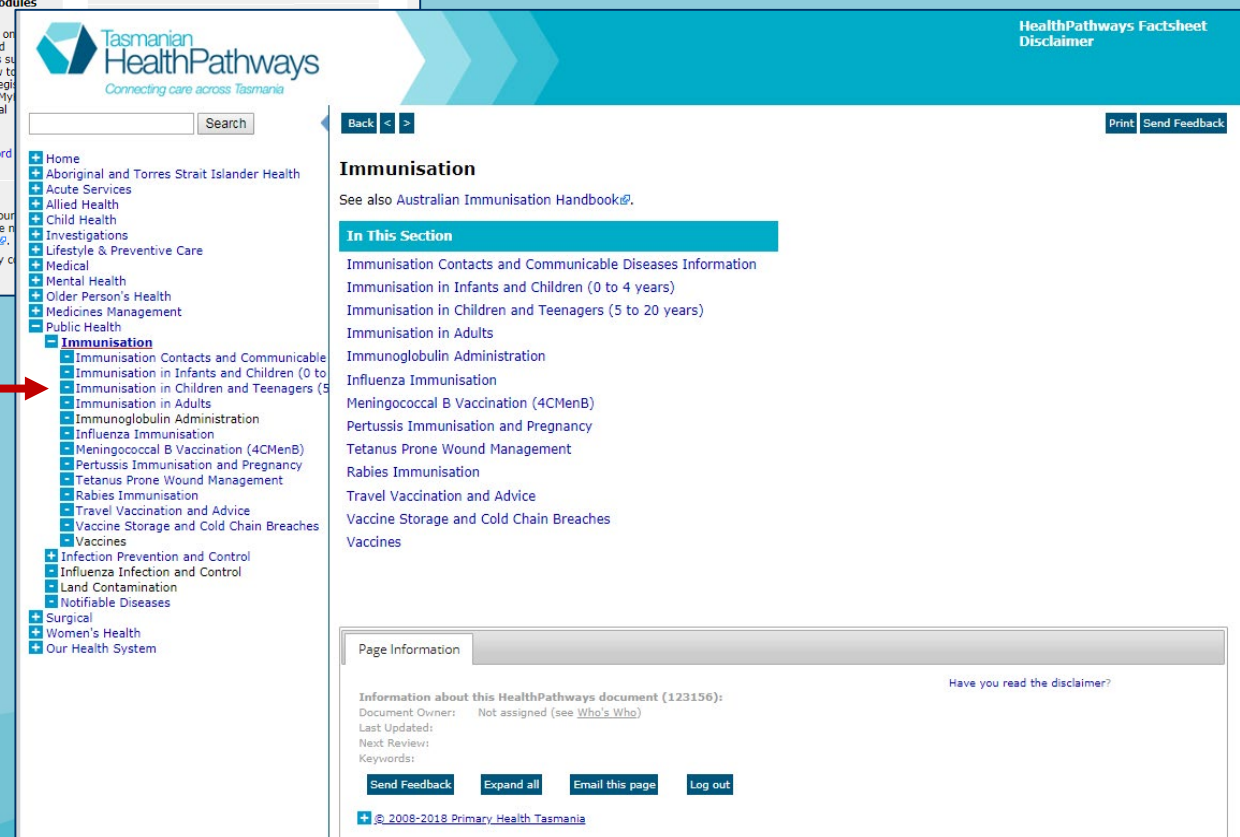

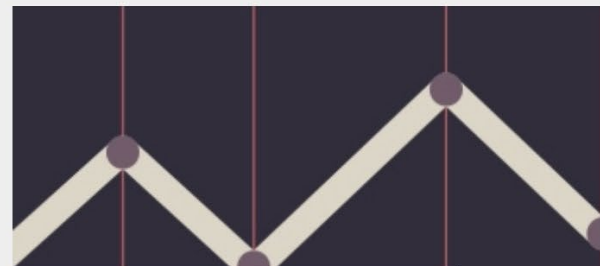
When to get the flu shot in Australia in 2019
