Director elections 2019

Under the Primary Health Tasmania Constitution (article 9) there is provision for up to nine directors through a mix of elected and appointed positions.

This year there are up to two elected director positions that the Board is seeking to fill in line with the 2019 Annual General Meeting (AGM).

Applications are sought from people with a range of industry skills particularly general practice, primary health care, health service design and delivery, and clinical governance. Geographical diversity will be taken into consideration across the Board profile with people in the northern areas including the north west and north east encouraged to apply.

All directors are expected to possess sound professional skills and personal attributes.

Elected terms are for three years.

Application process

- 1. Recruitment for the director vacancies **closes 10.00am Monday 16 September 2019** and is being widely advertised.
- 2. Applicants will need to:
 - complete the application form
 - provide a cover letter
 - address the selection criteria (see position description)
 - provide a CV.
- 3. Return completed application form and response to selection criteria via email or post:

 - Board Director Application, Primary Health Tasmania, GPO Box 1827, Hobart 7001.
- 4. A nominations committee has been convened to oversee assessment of applications and shortlist for interview with representation from the Board, tier 1 membership and an independent person. This committee is tasked with providing recommended candidates to the Board and for member vote.

Shortlisting will take place week starting 16 September 2019.

Interviews scheduled for 27 September 2019 (subject to change).
