Infectious diseases physician Professor Katie Flanagan will provide an update on a variety of infectious diseases topics.

Professor Flanagan is the head of the Infectious Diseases Service at the Launceston General Hospital, and a clinical professor at the University of Tasmania's School of Medicine. She is also an adjunct professor at the School of Health and Biomedical Science at RMIT University and the Department of Immunology and Pathology at Monash University.

Nurse practitioner Jane Laidlaw will provide a session on developing immunising services for those who are homeless, outlining:

- the tools needed to best meet the needs of this cohort
- how immunisation can start other key issues for this group.

A representative from the Australian Immunisation Register will provide information about the transition from authentication file to Provider Digital Access.

The Communicable Diseases Prevention Unit, leaders in developing and managing communicable diseases prevention and control activities that target the whole population in Tasmania, will present on the following topics:

- adverse effects following immunisation reporting

- vaccine ordering
- wastage and leakage.

- catch up immunisation schedules, including demonstration and tips
- how to avoid shoulder injury related to vaccine administration
