The workshop provides the background and orientation to stepped care, the initial assessment and referral process, and the decision support tool. In the second half of the workshop, participants engage in practical activity focusing on applying the IAR decision support tool to the prepared scenario.

GPs and GPs-in-training who complete the two-hour training will be eligible for a one-off payment of \$300 as remuneration for their time, unless the GP is employed full time with a government-funded service.
